



REGATHERING HEALTH & SAFETY PLAN

APOSTLES CHURCH BROOKLYN

We're regathering! While the city and state allowed churches to regather since last July, the leadership of Apostles Church has sought to move forward in the safest and most honoring way possible. We want to be fearless but not reckless, considering both your needs and the needs of our neighbors.

When we regather, things are going to look different. If you're considering joining us, please take a moment to review the below Health and Safety Plan. For the foreseeable future, this is what we'll be doing as a church and the actions we're asking you to take in helping us create a safe environment for everyone.

VENUE

We will be meeting at The Hilton in downtown Brooklyn ([140 Schermerhorn](#)). The Hilton is adhering to all NYS mandated health and safety guidelines and will sanitize the space prior to our arrival. PRE-REGISTRATION

While City and State regulations allow for religious gatherings to be at 50% capacity, we're limiting our in person gatherings to 33%. This means we have room for 45 people at the Hilton. Each person wishing to attend must pre-register to maintain this capacity limit. Pre-registration for the upcoming service, opens the Sunday prior at 6 PM and closes Wednesday at 11 PM.

You can sign up to attend our service by visiting brooklyn.apostles.nyc/sundays. Pre-registration links will also be posted in the Weekly Newsletter. In the event we reach capacity before the close of Wednesday night, anyone who wishes to attend will be added to the waitlist should we have any cancellations.

SELF-CHECK HEALTH ASSESSMENTS

Each person registered should complete their own self-check for COVID-19 symptoms (cough, fever, chills, muscle pain, difficulty breathing, sore throat, loss of taste or smell) and risk factors before attending any in-person event or gathering. Stay home if you are feeling unwell or if you've been in contact with anyone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days or if you should be quarantining according to [NYS travel guidelines](#).

CHECK-IN PROCESS

We ask that you arrive for service between 10:30 and 10:50 AM. If you arrive once check-in has concluded we won't be able to let you join the service, so please be on time! Upon arrival, each attendee will have their temperature checked using a contactless thermometer. Anyone reading a temperature of 100.4 will be asked to return home.

MASKS

Masks are required at all times for all adults. We strongly suggest children 2-4 years old wear masks while inside the venue. All children 4 and over are required to wear masks. We will provide a mask for those who need one.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

We've worked to create an environment that's conducive to social distancing and encourage all who registered together to remain at least 6ft apart from others during our services.

FOOD & DRINK

No food or drink will be served during our gathering, but feel free to bring your own water or coffee along with you.

HAND SANITIZER

Hand sanitizing stations will be provided throughout the venue (e.g check-in area, restrooms and meeting room).

APOSTLES KIDS

While we're excited to have families join us to worship, there is currently no Apostles Kids volunteer-led care at our gatherings. Parents with children who sign up to attend the service will be provided a family box to pick up that includes supplies for children to use while seated during the service.

DIGITAL GATHERINGS

We'll be streaming our services live on YouTube at 11 AM for those who can't join us in person. Prayer and Coffee Hour will remain on their current digital platforms. For all details visit
